**Step 1:** Apply to a CHW training that is Oregon Health Authority (OHA) approved.

**Step 2: G**et accepted, attend a training series, and complete all requirements<sup>\*</sup> for completion.

**Step 3:** Receive training completion certificate from the approved training organization.

\*As specified by the training organization and OHA.


**Step 4:** Fill out OHA's **application** to get certification (including a **background check**.)

**Step 5:** Wait to receive the following notification via email:



**Step 6:** You are now certified and enrolled on the **THW Registry**!

**Step 7:** To maintain CHW certification, you need to submit a **renewal application** to OHA, and complete 20 CHW continuing education unit (CEU) credits every 3 years.
