

HOW TO BECOME A CERTIFIED

COMMUNITY HEALTH WORKER

IN THE STATE OF OREGON

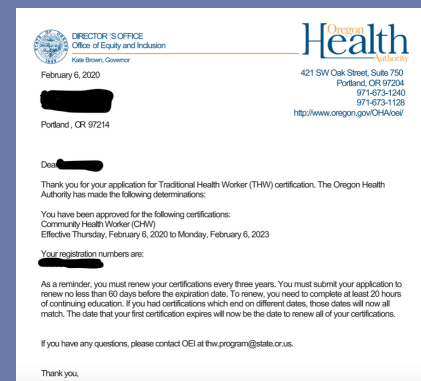
STEP 1: Apply to a CHW training that is OHA approved.

STEP 2: Get accepted and attend training series, and complete all requirements* for completion.

STEP 3: Receive training completion certificate from approved training organization.

STEP 4: Fill out an application to get certification through OHA (including a background check)

STEP 5: Wait to receive the following via email:



STEP 6: Fully certified and enrolled in registry (renew after 3 years).

Requirements* fill out daily session evaluations, participate in daily end-of-day group evaluations, complete 5 session summaries, end of series role play, end of series evaluation, pre-post assessment and attendance requirements.
